- 1. Station Controllers are authorized to impose penalties of fine, recovery, forfeiture and removal on any person(s) committing any of the offences mentioned above in the Jaipur Metro Rail premises, which includes the entire station premises and metro trains.
- 2. Depot Controllers are authorized to impose these penalties on any person(s) committing any of the offences mentioned above in the Mansarovar Depot of Jaipur Metro, which includes the entire Depot premises and metro trains.
- 3. Station Controllers of Mansarovar and Sindhi Camp Stations are authorized to impose these penalties on any person(s) committing any of the offences mentioned above respectively in the entire premises of Mansarovar and Sindhi Camp Receiving Sub Stations of Jaipur Metro.
- 4. Station Superintendents, Commercial Inspector, Manager (Operations), Manager (Train Operations) & Manager (Commercial) are authorized to impose these penalties on any person(s) committing any of the offences mentioned above in the metro trains of Jaipur Metro.

In case any offender does not pay the fine/comply with the penalty as imposed by any Jaipur Metro official hereby authorized or the penalty of imprisonment is sought to be awarded in lieu of or in addition to fine, the above Jaipur Metro officials will be authorized to detain the offenders and hand them over to the Police for producing them before the judicial authorities.
